**ENERGY MANAGEMENT POLICY STATEMENT**

The Nairobi Hospital is committed to improving energy efficiency by establishing programmes, and a culture of energy management that is repeatable, timely, and cost effective from both financial and environmental perspectives.

**Scope:**

This policy is applicable to all activities carried out in the Hospital and outpatient centers either by ourselves or on our behalf. Its implementation is the role of every employee and shall be integrated in the day to day operations through a systematic, proactive and transparent manner.

**To achieve this, we shall:**

1. Integrate energy management within the Hospital's processes as well as other Hospital standards.
2. Consider appropriate energy management in upgrade, design, and development of Hospital projects.
3. Engage external providers and contractors on energy management as applicable.
4. Fulfil applicable compliance obligations related to energy management.
5. Monitor, measure and analyse energy management performance.
6. Provide avenues for inculcating a culture on energy management.
7. Protect the environment by championing the cause for conservation and seeking to use renewable energy sources and purchasing compliant renewable energy machines.
8. Identify cost saving opportunities from energy efficiency measures and efficient use of resources.
9. Provide necessary resource for effective functioning and improvement of energy management programmes.
10. Require each employee to take individual and collective responsibility on energy management.
11. Periodically conduct internal and external energy audits to identify opportunities for improvement and energy conservation.
12. Continually improve the suitability, adequacy and effectiveness of energy management within the Hospital.
