Scope:

5. Prudent waste management programmes.
6. Setting environmental targets and tracking achievement of the Hospital key environmental performance indicators including environmental risks and opportunities.
7. Provision of required resources for effective management and implementation of Environmental Management System.
8. Continuous training on Environmental Management System.
9. Employee's individual as well as collective responsibility for the effectiveness of the Environmental Management System.
10. Communication of this policy to staff and other stakeholders and relevant interested parties.
11. Continual improvement of the Environmental Management System.
